2024 - 2025 School Year

For over 50 years The New Metropolitan Detroit Club of The National Association of Negro Business and Professional Women's Clubs, Inc. [NMD NANBPWC] has had a special commitment to helping youth pursue and realize their formal college education and career goals. We are offering scholarships to June 2026 graduating high school seniors. A number of \$1,000 and \$500 scholarships are offered. Several are restricted to students attending a Black college/university [HBCU]. The remaining are awarded regardless of the college or university attending [College of Choice].

Requirements

June 2026 graduate - 3.0 GPA or above on a 4.0 scale Must enroll in an accredited college or university by Fall of 2026

Scholarship package must include:

- *Completed scholarship application
- *Two recommendations signed and on official stationery [school, community, work and/or church]
- *Transcript (must provide 7th semester grades; December/January)
- *College entrance exam scores (ACT or SAT)
- *<u>List</u> of extra-curricular activities (leadership positions, significant accomplishments, and any employment, etc.)
- *Essay on one of the following topics (typed, minimum 300 word/maximum two pages, in 11 or 12pt font, double-spaced; Essays will be evaluated on content, addressing topic, and grammar)

(Required topic for students applying for a Black College Scholarship)

or

(Required topic for students applying for a College of Choice Scholarship)
